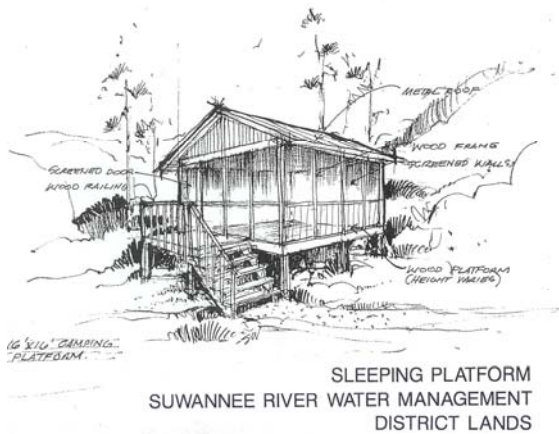


SBA Spring Hop Weekend Canoe & Kayak Trip
